The February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011 minutes was considered by the Directors. **Motion** by Rogers to approve the February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011 minutes as written. Medrick seconded the motion and it passed.

The Board was presented with the March 2011 bills and accounts. **Motion** by Medrick to accept the March 2011 bills and accounts as presented. Colson seconded the motion and it passed.

**Operational/Administrative Reports**

Chairman Gallob signs the DMR's. Lippert informs the Board that one aerator motor has been replaced but another motor has burned up and that there is a spare motor waiting for pick up at Tom's Electric. Rogers states that Nucla and Naturita are protesting about the new regulations that are being enforced now. Lippert states that he has not seen any evidence of ammonia damage, but the State is pushing for all sewer lagoons to go to a mechanical plant which will cost in excess of a million dollars to set up. Lippert asks the Board to approve a vacation request for March 28<sup>th</sup> to April 1, 2011. He is hoping to get the new pickup for NSD while going to Denver for a high school basketball game. It was the consensus of the Board to approve the vacation request.
